THEMES & CONTENT

Thoracic tube placement is a common procedure in the surgical and non-surgical setting. It may be needed in the thoracic trauma context or in cases of other benign less acute pathology (for example, drainage of pleural effusion).

In this workshop, we will explore the clinical settings in which a thoracostomy is necessary, the different techniques, and its adequacy. Learning will be based on theoretical lectures, clinical cases discussion, and living models training. In the end, there will be a self-assessment questionnaire (10 multiple-choice questions).

GOALS

- > Knowledge of thoracostomy techniques (therapeutic and decompressive).
- > Choosing the adequate thoracostomy techniques for each clinical setting.
- > Practical training in a living animal.
