THEMES & CONTENT

According to the International Association for the Study of Pain, pain is an unpleasant multidimensional experience, involving not only a sensory component but also an emotional component, which is associated with a concrete or potential tissue injury, or is described as a function of this lesion.

Pain management should be carried out at all levels of the health care delivery network, beginning with Primary Health Care and continuing, where necessary, to increasing levels of differentiation and specialization.
